FINANCIAL:

Reviewed and coded invoices for AP processing

VIOLATIONS:

Inspections of community completed at intervals.

LANDSCAPE ITEMS/ISSUES:

 Erosion repair at the end of Ponte Bella west of 74th Way. A proposal was requested from Mike Smyth.

MANAGER ACTION ITEMS:

- Presented a draft of the 2014-2015 Budget to the Budget and Finance Committee meeting on February 13th
- The Building and Grounds Committee meeting was cancelled for February and March.
- One culvert needed cleaning and Apache Plumbing has completed.
- Received proposals from two door companies to bring them into compliance per Maricopa's new ordinance. They are not included in this Board package as they will be presented to the Building and Grounds Committee who will recommend the contractor to the Board of Directors.
- Sun Devil Fire Equipment completed the annual sprinkler system inspection and submitted bid to have 24 hour fire monitoring since we no longer have 24 hour guard coverage. Another proposal was also obtained. We are meeting with ADT on Wednesday March 26th for their proposal. The Security Committee has been asked to join us.
- The State of Arizona's Industrial Commission of Arizona, Division of Occupational Safety and Health, Boiler Safety Inspection made a surprise visit to Bellasera. He found one pool heater that needs a valve removed and a part on the boiler system for the steam rooms that needs replacement. Arizona Systems Design is tentatively planning on repairing it next week providing the part comes in as scheduled. The pool heater issue has been addressed.
- Stanley Steemers has completed the cleaning and sealing of the slate throughout the Clubhouse.
- As there is an issue with rats in the electrical boxes damaging the wiring for the monument signs, Associated Contracting Resources is working on cleaning them out and sealing them in such a way that rats will not be able to get into them.
