MANAGEMENT REPORT

FINANCIAL:

- Reviewed and coded invoices for AP processing
- Reviewed financials
- Prepared MTD & YTD variance reports
- Forwarded AR and attorney reports to Paul Snyder for his delinquency report

VIOLATIONS:

Inspection of property at intervals.

LANDSCAPE ITEMS/ISSUES:

- Maintenance crew worked along the entry way, along Pontebella up to Corva, the parking lot & Club House area, 76th St. entry and along Corva and 77th and Balao. Tree pruning was a major focus following recent winds, pruning plants as needed and weed removal continue. Follow up post emergent for weeds, targeting areas around the Club House and throughout the property was completed last week.
- The crew fertilized the rye grass on May 24th and the next fertilization is scheduled in June.
- The rye grass is being mowed weekly at 2" height. The turf is irrigated 4 days per week for 45 minute run times start time is 12:30 am. Irrigation is programmed and mow height set for Bermuda promotion.
- The annual flowers have been planted.
- The annual arbor tree trim is scheduled to begin June 21st.

MANAGER ACTION ITEMS:

- Met with Building and Grounds committee on Tuesday, June14th
- A major repair was completed with the drain located in the men's bathroom and which also services the ladies bathroom. A part had to be replaced; however, it was found that gym wipes are being flushed down the toilets. If the leak had not occurred, a plumbing company would have been called shortly as the wipes would have blocked the pipe.
- Many of the six pool umbrellas that were purchased last month have already broken. I am searching for a more durable and heavier umbrella that will withstand winds, etc.
- I have contacted Tom McDonald for help preparing a scope of work for the pool deck repairs.
- Working on obtaining road reflectors for such areas as Balao between Visao and Brisa. Replace those that have come off along Pontebella to Corva.
- Four Peaks is preparing a proposal for river rock for three areas where the wash meets the sidewalk.
- Obtaining a proposal from Four Peaks for placing large rocks at mailbox kiosks to prevent vehicles from making a u-turn and displacing granite at those areas.

• The bottom bulkhead on the spa filter is cracked and leaking and needs to be replaced. This will include changing out 500 pounds of sand. Total cost is approximately \$426.00. The work will be completed this week.

- Bees were removed at an irrigation box between 7462 and 7474 Visao.
- Two HVAC units (AC-4 & AC-5) were damaged by hail and requires the comb-out of coil fins. This work is scheduled to be completed shortly.
- Reviewing the proposals received for the landscape maintenance.
- Replied to e-mails and phone calls.

UPCOMING:

- A proposal has been received from Four Peaks for the next re-veg area which is for the front entrance and along Pontebella Dr. to Corva. This is presently on hold.
- Will obtain additional proposals for the pool deck repair.

- Drive community specifically for monitoring lots for number of trees to meet Community Wide Standards of Landscaping as adopted by the BOD
